Peace be unto you and praise the Lord. I am writing to communicate the scriptural references that His Eminence wants you to have. You are encouraged to order the sermon on DVD in order to get the complete message in context.

Pretext:

The four gospels provide us with insight and detail about Jesus Christ. During today's message we understood the different points highlighted across the gospels concerning Christ. There is no conflict, rather an opportunity to study, rightly divide and believe the Lord. Matthew emphasizes the fulfillment of Old Testament prophecy about who Jesus is. It points to the long awaited Messiah and Jewish King.

Mark brings out the humanity, service and sacrifice of Christ. We read about compassion, anger, hunger, limited knowledge (time specific) among other things.

Luke dwells on healing, Christ's compassion and the fact that Christ came to those considered as outcasts in Israel. Gentiles have access. He comes to those that recognize their need. Women are highlighted as well.

John is quite clear about detailing the fact that Jesus is God.
